#### The Goal

- To provide a comprehensive, affordable benefits program for Medicare and non-Medicare City retirees and their eligible dependents, and develop a larger group with diverse health risk levels to achieve sustainability.

- Mail order is 2.5 times the monthly co-pay: \$50/\$87.50/\$125
- Choice HSA must pay full price for prescriptions until deductible is fulfilled.
   Then co-pays for the remainder of the year.

These premiums have already been reduced by the City Qualified Contribution plus a 10% reduction using the Retiree Rate Stabilization Fund. To arrive at your bottom line cost, deduct your monthly MERP from the premiums shown above. Public Safety retirees should also deduct their State subsidy amount.



# Medicare Supplement Plans & Medicare Pharmacy Plans

You'll have a LOWER PREMIUM when you enroll in a Medicare Supplement Plan through the City of Phoenix UnitedHealthcare AARP Plan:

- 5% premium discount and
- \$30 per month Qualified City Contribution that further reduces your premium.
- \$90 per month Qualified City Contribution for Sworn Fire Retirees
- AARP membership.



#### Why a Supplement Plan?

- No Provider Network
  - You can see <u>any</u> physician who accepts Medicare.
  - 87% of Family Medicine Doctors
  - 99% of General Surgeons
  - 98% of Orthopedic Surgeons
  - 63% of Psychiatrists
- A Supplement Plan may pay some of your Part A and Part B out-of-pocket costs such as deductibles.



- No geographic limitations coverage goes with you across the United States.
- You can see specialists without a referral.
- Some plans cover emergency care out of the country.
- Buy a separate prescription drug plan that fits your needs.



#### **Enrollment is not guaranteed.**

 If you are already in another Supplement Plan or any Medicare Advantage Plan, you can apply for coverage through AARP/UHC by completing a form or applying by phone.



### **Medical Underwriting**

- Takes 5 to 7 days from the day UHC receives your application.
- If additional information is needed, UHC will call you. <u>The</u> sooner you take the call, the sooner they can make a decision.
- Do not cancel your current coverage until you hear from AARP/UHC that your 2020 application was approved.



If you are not approved by AARP/UHC for a Medicare Supplement Plan through the City of Phoenix, you can:

- 1. Continue your current Medicare plan into 2020, or
- 2. Work with a Health Market agent to identify other options.



- You may have received a large white envelope from AARP Medicare Supplement Plans. Review the information enclosed and complete the enrollment form at the back of the Plan Guide. Mail it to UHC using the envelope provided with the packet.
- Or, call UHC customer service to enroll by phone.

### Catastrophic Rx Program

The City of Phoenix funds the Catastrophic Rx Program for its benefits eligible Medicare retirees and their dependents when they are enrolled in any Medicare Part D pharmacy plan. When drug coverage expenses reach the Medicare catastrophic coverage level, reimbursement of up to \$25,000 annually is available.



- A legally married spouse or Qualified Domestic Partner (QDP) can be enrolled in a medical plan without the retiree being enrolled in a medical plan when the retiree is Medicare and the spouse or QDP is not Medicare.
- Dental and vision plans require the retiree to be enrolled for the spouse or QDP to be enrolled.
- If the retiree has insufficient pension for deductions, enrollment is limited to the medical plan and a monthly direct premium payment to the City will be arranged.
